

# Winsor & Newton Global Brand Team People Changes

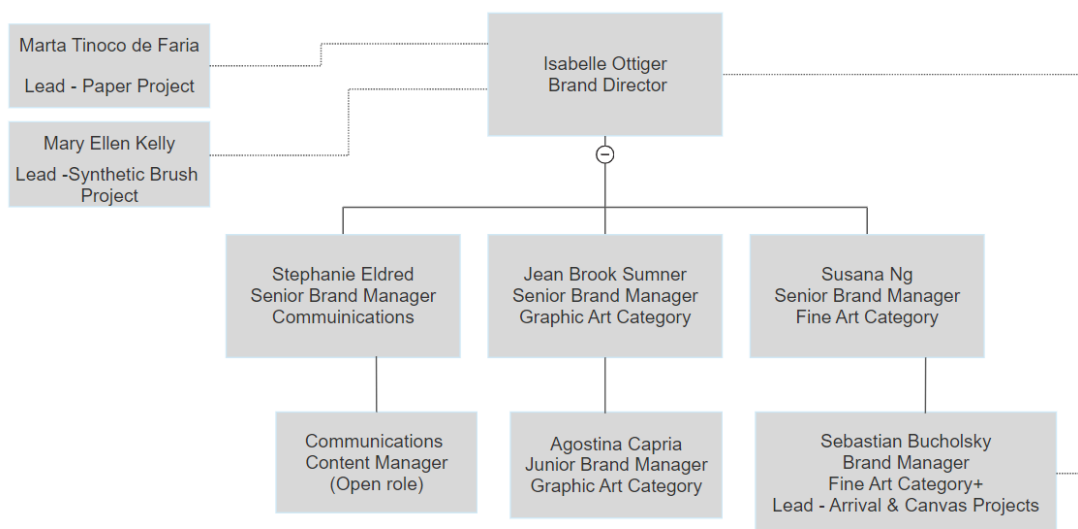
A lot is going on in the Winsor & Newton brand team lately, with several people changes.
