On Friday 26th February, we held the fortnightly Town Hall Meeting hosted by CEO Dennis van Schie.

Dennis shared some inspiration with us as he is currently reading "Endure" from Alex Hutchinson; this book is all about mind over body or how you can push and accelerate performance. Dennis spoke of the hope that successful vaccination programmes are providing in the UK, coupled with spring and summer months arriving. As always, he reminded us of the importance of following government guidelines to ensure our health and safety.

In this "fantastic" town hall, Dennis discusses the launch of the Long Range Plan and how this will be communicated to everybody in Colart. He brings together our vision as our purpose; our mission that sets us apart from the competition and our strategy, and how this plan of action is what we have chosen to do in every way.
