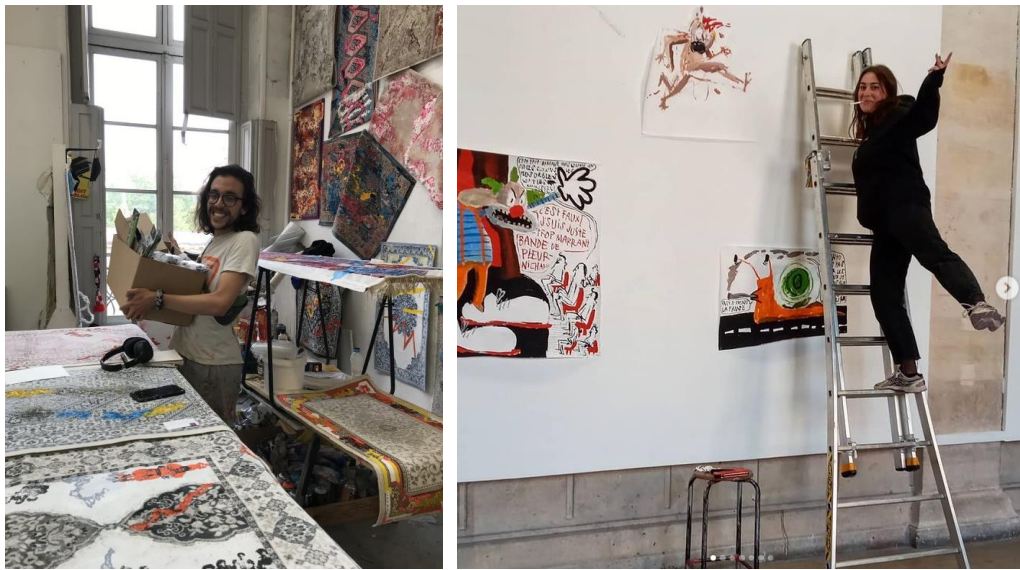


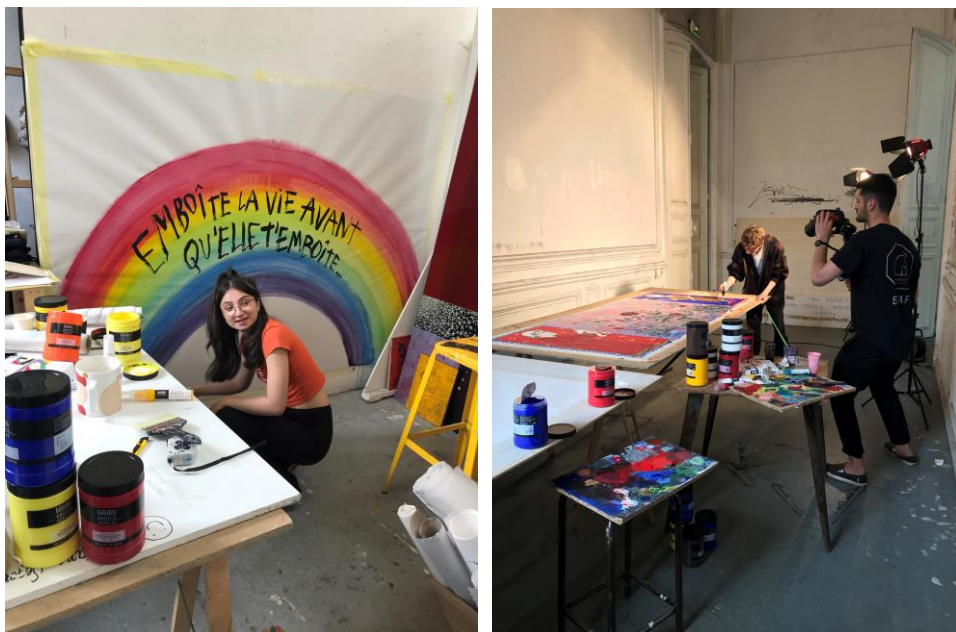
Liquitex art in the city of Paris

A Partnership with the Fine Arts School of Paris & Parcours Saint Germain Exhibit.

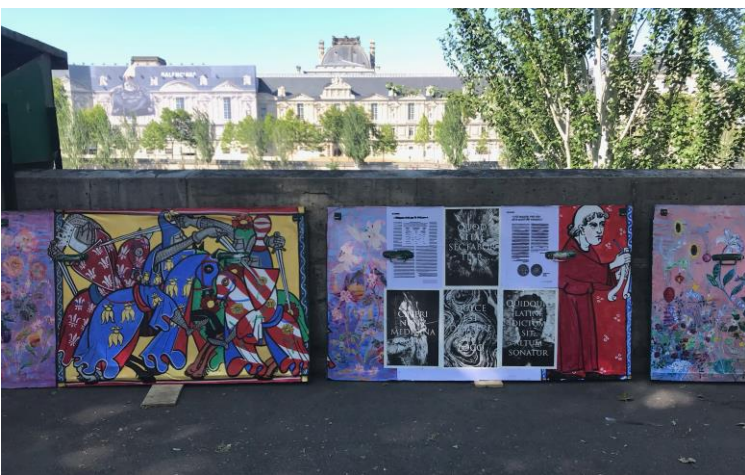
