

Richard Llewellyn - Chief Sustainability Officer at Colart

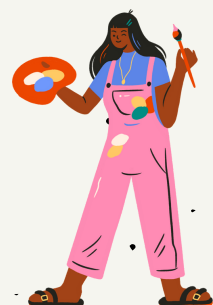
1983

Moved to the procurement team - finished goods portfolio and set up vendor rating system and helped implement the first Colart computerised procurement ERP system.



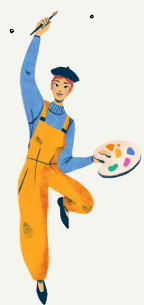
1991
